Many mothers and fathers raise children as single parents because of divorce, the death of a spouse, or an unplanned pregnancy. Over the past couple of decades, the practice of choosing to be a single parent--through adoption or the use of donor sperm or surrogates--has become more common. Because a woman's fertility and her ability to bear a healthy baby declines with age, some women decide to be impregnated with donor sperm even though they have not found a man they want to marry.
