Write an essay answering the following prompt and submit it with your scantron on your final exam.

Your paper should have at least three components:

- 1. How are the problems of terrorism, environmental problems, and humanitarian crises related? Be specific and use the book, lectures, or a credible outside source.
- 2. What would EITHER a realist, a liberal, OR a constructivist say about the interconnectedness among terrorism, environmental problems, and humanitarian crises? The book will come in handy here. Choose an ideology and read what your ideology says about all three problems. Then, find a connection among how your ideology feels.
- 3. Suggest at least ONE thing the U.S. can do with another country that would address all three issues. Explain why. Feel free to be creative on this part. Think of a policy, or action, or speech, or something the U.S. can do with another country to address all three: terrorism, environmental problems, and humanitarian crises. Explain what your suggestion would accomplish and why you think it would be effective.

The most important thing is that <u>all 3</u> are addressed. I think it should take about 2-5 pages to do a thorough job. I don't care about fonts, margins, etc., as long as the paper is well-written and legible.

Be sure your paper has good grammar and a minor amount of mechanical errors. I am more interested in your ideas than your mistakes, but you should still proofread carefully to minimize mistakes.

You don't have to use any outside sources. But - if you do - be sure to cite them correctly using the citation style of your choice.
