

**Requirements for Paper 2** (due 2/28, 5pm)

- 1) Craft a 3–4 page essay that *directly* answers one of the three prompts.
- 2) Use standard margins, Times, 12pt font. Do not re-adjust if you exceed length.
- 3) Identify the *relevant* sources that fit your chosen prompt and make sure you have read them closely, especially primary documents. Reading Kuhn chapters 3 and 4 is *essential* for all prompts.
- 4) You will not be using outside sources, so parenthetical citation with the corresponding page numbers is preferred. There is no need to use citation when referring to my own lectures.
- 5) Make sure you have an appropriate title.
- 6) You are *required* to have an *introductory paragraph* of about 200 words (under one page, 250 max). It should consist of
  - (a) *Concise* introductory hook (3–4 sentences)
  - (b) *Thesis statement* that is a direct and specific answer to prompt questions. Emulating same language construction is useful. (You will need more than single sentence.)
  - (c) You will need a *roadmap* suggesting structure of essay (can be thesis or additional sentence).
- 7) You must also have a *concluding paragraph* that summarizes main points and *restates thesis* statement. Suggestion: Work with a tentative thesis and then revise thesis based on conclusion (by then you will know what paper is about). Intro and conclusion should *mirror* each other.
