Requirements for Paper 2 (due 2/28, 5pm)

1)	Craft a 3–4 page essay that <i>directly</i> answers one of the three prompts.
2)	Use standard margins, Times, 12pt font. Do not re-adjust if you exceed length.
3)	Identify the <i>relevant</i> sources that fit your chosen prompt and make sure you have read them closely, especially primary documents. Reading Kuhn chapters 3 and 4 is <i>essential</i> for all prompts.
4)	You will not be using outside sources, so parenthetical citation with the corresponding page numbers is preferred. There is no need to use citation when referring to my own lectures.
5)	Make sure you have an appropriate title.
6)	You are <i>required</i> to have an <i>introductory paragraph</i> of about 200 words (under one page, 250 max). It should consist of
	(a) <i>Concise</i> introductory hook (3–4 sentences)
	(b) <i>Thesis statement</i> that is a direct and specific answer to prompt questions. Emulating same language construction is useful. (You will need more than single sentence.)
	(c) You will need a <i>roadmap</i> suggesting structure of essay (can be thesis or additional sentence).
7)	You must also have a <i>concluding paragraph</i> that summarizes main points and <i>restates thesis</i> statement. Suggestion: Work with a tentative thesis and then revise thesis based on conclusion (by then you will know what paper is about). Intro and conclusion should <i>mirror</i> each other.
