Remember to consider who hired you (the law firm in the final project) and, therefore, to whom you are responsible to disclose information.

Guidelines for Submission: You should submit a well-developed and theory based treatment strategy for the case study client from PSY 622. Your paper must be submitted as a 2–3 page Microsoft Word document with double spacing, 12-point Times New Roman font, one-inch margins, and sources cited in APA format.
